If two tours can set a pattern, it is to play some shows in smaller venues. The Warfield Benefit Shows here were for audiences just over 2000. Tickets sold out weeks in advance. On the current tour, similar shows are scheduled in small colleges--they are listed on neither Hotline nor Mikel. If you are lucky enough to have a ticket, great! Otherwise do not show up. Tickets will not be available at the door. The presence of many extra fans may make it impossible for the DEAD to play in small houses (vital to their integrity) in the future. Please cooperate.
