HUNTER (DAVID STANFORD) PLAYS RAINBOW SEP 15

CROUCHED BENEATH THE DUST OF THE SATURDAY NIGHT STOCK CAR RACES AT THE FAIRGROUNDS NEXT DOOR, THE ALER-EMPTY BAR WAS A MARKED CONTRAST TO THE SCENE OF HUNTER'S PREVIOUS SHOW, PLAYED TO A NEAR-CAPACITY CROWD IN THE ELEGANT TRALFAMADORE CAFE IN BUFFALO TWO NIGHTS EARLIER. (MY TAPE OF THE BUFFALO SHOW DIDN'T COME OUT BECAUSE I FORGOT TO PUT BATTERIES IN MY MICROPHONE, SO I CAN'T PROVIDE THE SONG LIST, BUT I DO RECALL THAT IT INCLUDED SUGAR & BOX OF RAIN, AND THAT THE MASON'S CHILDREN WAS MIXTURED AS "THAT OTHER ALTRAMONT SONG.") HUNTER SEEMED MORE AT EASE WITH THE SMALLER CROWD, AND MIXED IN A LOT OF BANTER. HE ASKED FOR SUGGESTIONS AS TO WHICH ROUTE TO TAKE IN HIS RENT-A-CAR FOR HIS NEXT SHOW IN VIRGINIA BEACH, AND SAID OF HIS LOW ALBUM SALES: "THAT'S OKAY, I GET ROYALTIES FROM THE BIG BOYS; I DON'T HURT." HE ALSO HAD FUN SURPRISES THE

CROWD WITH UNFAMILIAR VERSES TO SONGS SUCH AS TRUCKIN':

"S.F. WAS A ROCKIN' TOWN
AT ONE TIME WE EVEN MADE THE SOUND
CAUTION, SPREAD THE WORD AROUND
BEFORE THOSE MOTHER TRUCKERS SHUT US DOWN."

HUNTER STROLLED AROUND AND CHATTED WITH FANS BEFORE STARTING THE SECOND SET, SO I GOT TO SHAKE THE HAND THAT FELLED "SHAKE THE HAND THAT SHOOK THE HAND..." WHO NEEDED STANFORD?

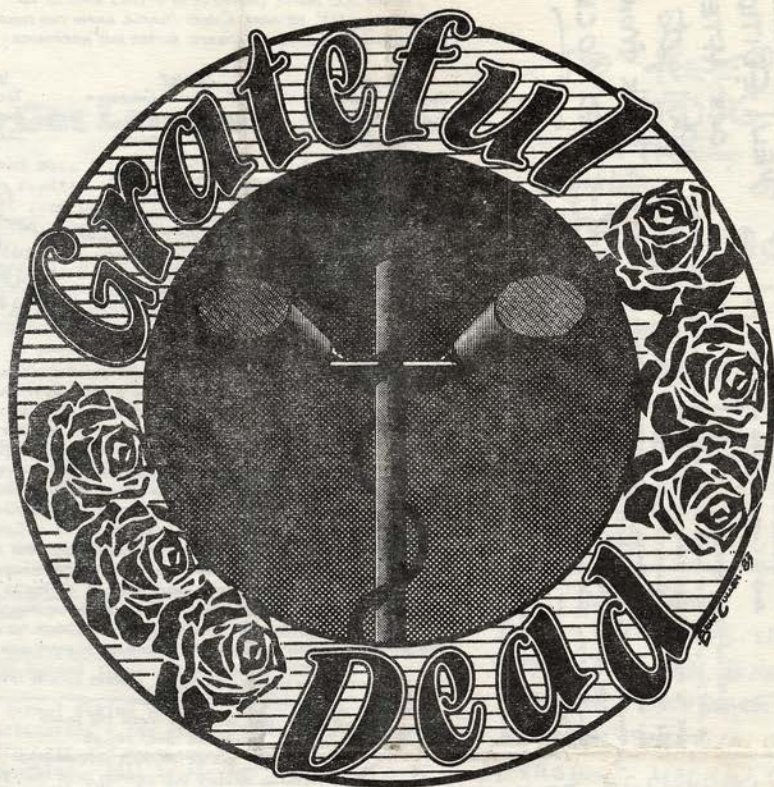
