A NEW PUBLICATION IS BORN

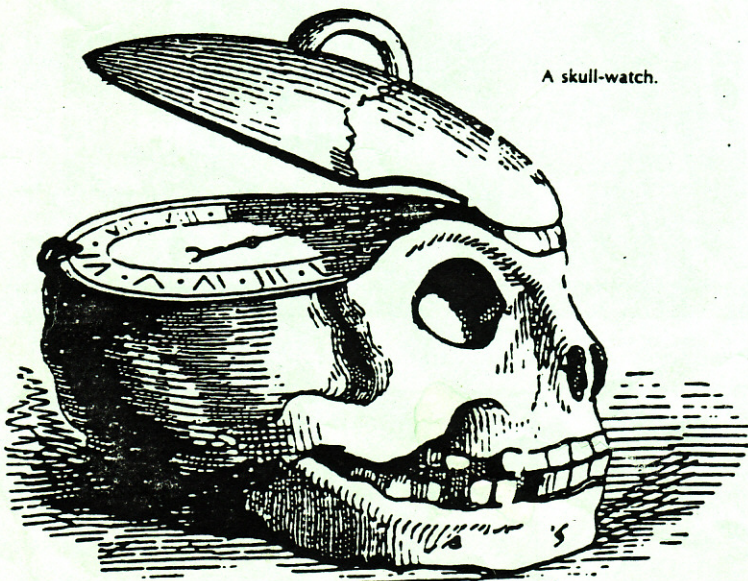

Feeling confident in having regained the positive audience they once had, both John and Peter decided this would be an opportune time to continue independently of each other. To this end, Peter Martin will once again take full control of Terrapin Flyer, using it as a free handout at shows only, and John will take back control of Dead Beat.

To fill the void of Terrapin Flyer, John Dwork, Lee J. Randell and Sally Ansonge have decided to continue their partnership with a new endeavor -- **DUPREE'S DIAMOND NEWS.** They will take up with DDN where they left off with Terrapin Flyer.
