The Rock Round-Up spotted Bruce Springsteen at the second U2 show in Philadelphia. He seems to be quite a fan of the band. He also attended a dinner afterwards with Bono and Larry Mullen at a local restaurant.

Two weeks ago, Jimmy Page was arrested in his home for possession of a controlled substance. He spent that night in a Reading jail, and was released the next day on bail. He now faces charges.

Eddy Grant starts a tour in support of Killer on the Rampage LP on June 1st in Germany. He then plays most of Europe before doing the States, which will begin during the second week of July. Grant has also just finished a new LP that will be kept in the can until next year.

The London Symphony Orchestra-Zappa Vol.

I is the name of the forthcoming Frank Zappa record that contains four compositions of his chamber music. The record, which will be in the stores on June 13th, was digitally recorded. The songs are "Sad Jane", "Pedro's Dowery", "Envelope", and "Moe And Herb's Vacation".

Romeo Void are now writing and rehearsing material for their third album, which will be recorded later this summer. They will be doing sporadic West Coast dates including one date with U2 on June 1st in San Fransisco. Romeo Void's singer Deborah Iyall will be getting married on June 18th.

As reported, The Waitresses recently lost singer Patty Donahue. Now, her replacement Holly Beth Vincent has also just left. No comment has been given on future state of affairs for the rest of the band or on another replacement.

Ray Manzarek at Cherokee Studios in West Hollywood. The tentative release date is August 15th. Two videos will be shot from the alburn. A U.S. tour will start in September at the Greek Theatre. X has also done the title track to the new movie Breathless, and they will be appearing on the Jerry Lewis Telethon Labor Day Weekend.

Gang Of Four are working on a new album in Montreal with producers Howard and Ronald Albert. The album and a tour will come in September.

Bite is the name of the forthcoming album from Altered Images, to be released during the first week in July. They have a new single out now in the U.K. called "Bring Me Closer". They will do a

tour of Britain in August and the States in September.

Aroma Discs are a new product from Environmental Fragrance Technologies that are 3 inch discs and an accompanying player that will fragrantize a room in two to three minutes. The idea behind the Aroma Disc is to make them go along with your stereo and video equipment to set a mood. The Aroma Disc & Player will be released this fall, initially with 40 different scents.

The new record from Kansas will be released near the end of July, and it's called Drastic Measures. No word on a tour yet.

Blue Oyster Cult have just entered the studio to work on a new album. The producer for this LP is Bruce Fairbairn, who just produced Loverboy's new LP. BOC will be going to Germany to play two stadium dates there on June 18th & 19th. The album will be out by the end of August, with a major tour in September.

Jon Anderson and Vangellis will have a new LP out on July 11th called *Private Collection*. We have also learned that Jon Anderson and Chris Squire are talking to each other again.

Former Genesis guitarist Steve Hackett will have his new solo album coming at the end of June called *Highly Strung*. There will be a video done to the song "Cell 151", and a tour is being planned for the summer.

The Rockats are doing songs for a remake of the movie Where The Boys Are. They are in Florida now recording two originals and two covers for the film, and they will also be performing these songs in the movie. Their tour will continue after the shooting is finished.

NEW MUSIC REPORT

Bauhaus, who can be seen in the opening scene in Bowie's The Hunger, will have their fourth LP out on July 19th. It's called Burning From This Inside. Bauhaus will tour the States in September.

Adele Bertei, formerly of The Contortions and The Bloods, has been signed to Geffen Records as a solo artist. She will be releasing a 12" in early June called "Build Me A Bridge". She will be recording a mini-LP this summer, which will be produced by Thomas Dolby. That should be out in September.






